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## Application for enrolment for the European qualifying examination 2000

**Applications should be submitted as early as possible to give the Examination Secretariat sufficient time to check whether the conditions for enrolment have been fulfilled.**

The application must be received by the European Patent Office not later than **12 November 1999**. If the examination fee is not validly paid in due time, the application will be deemed not to have been received.

I am familiar with the Regulation on the European qualifying examination (REE) as referred to below (OJ EPO 1994, 7). I have ticked the boxes which apply to me. I hereby apply to be enrolled for the European qualifying examination from **5 to 7 April 2000**.

### 1. First-time enrolment: full sitting or modular sitting
